

## MECKLENBURG COUNTY Area Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services January 09, 2012

### **PROVIDER HOT SHEET**

- ⇒ The LME, in partnership with Mecklenburg's PROMISE, is offering monthly, comprehensive 2-day training on creating person-centered plans (PCPs) for adult mental health consumers that integrate Recovery Model principles, a person-centered approach, effective and proactive crisis planning, and demonstration of medical necessity. The training is mandatory for the staff of Mecklenburg County's adult mental health IPRS providers who create PCPs, and is strongly encouraged for MOA providers, in preparation for working within a Waiver environment. The trainings, delivered by Mecklenburg's PROMISE Training Team and LME UM staff, will be held at The Watkins Center, free of charge. Sessions are currently available for February 28 and March 1, as well as March 20 and March 22; additional dates will be added in the future. - ⇒ Plans for Achieving Self Support (PASS) PASS represents a huge untapped resource that puts money directly in the hands of people who need resources to find and keep employment through earned wages or business ownership. PASS funding is consumer-controlled money to go get a job, earn a college degree to enhance employability, to acquire specialized skills, to buy job development and coaching services and to cover transit costs. PASS information.
- ⇒ The Division of Medical Assistance (DMA) has asked the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) for an extension for the current 2008 CAP MR/DD waiver. The extension was requested because DMA and DMHDDSAS are working with CMS to review NC's progress on our 2008 CAP MR/DD waiver transition plan for recipients residing in facilities with more than 16 beds and the Divisions are addressing final questions about transition to the new waiver requirements.

When the waiver is approved by CMS, DMA will publish the final services with the effective start date of the waiver. The proposed implementation date for the renewal CAP I/DD waivers will be April 1, 2012.

The January 2012 Medicaid Bulletin includes guidance on the need for revisions to the PCP in various scenarios due to the extension of the 2008 CAP MR/DD Waiver. ⇒ The Star Rating review team composed of CFAC members, provider representatives and LME staff continues to meet. Several decisions have been made concerning specific standards. <u>Attendance is no longer required at InfoShare, Provider Council General Meetings or Best Practice Committees as a standard in the Star Rating or as an LME expectation.</u> CFAC sincerely hopes that providers will recognize the value of staying informed about current issues and of networking opportunities with other providers as the LME moves toward waiver implementation.

CFAC has begun to work with the LME, the LME's Public Service and Information specialist, Andrew Fair, and Mecklenburg advocacy organizations to finalize a waiver communication plan for consumers and other stakeholders. CFAC looks forward to working with the Provider Council Executive Board and provider community to develop a consistent message about the waiver for consumers and the community.
