# Charlotte Center City Partners Board of Directors Meeting May 10, 2012 Wake Forest University

Welcome from Todd Johnson, President, Wake Forest University Executive Board.

#### **Executive Session**

Called to order at 3:12pm with Board and Senior Staff. There was discussion on the 7<sup>th</sup> Street Public Market financing and governance, with discussion and a vote in open session.

The Board voted to approve request for a 15-year economic development grant to support the Knights AAA Ballpark.

Executive Session also included review of CEO with Board and Michael Smith only. Michael was excused for final portion of review discussion.

Executive Session ended at 5:05pm

General session called to order 5:10 pm

Minutes from February 16, 2012 were approved as written

#### **Financial Report**

Bob Hambright reported results are favorable to budget.

#### **Budget**

Bob referred the board to the budget materials included in the Board book. Charlotte Center City Partners is budgeting FY13 revenue of \$4,277,510. The MSD allotment from the City, which is 75% of total revenues, is projected to be \$3,200,010. CCCPCT (formerly Charlotte ArtsFest) revenue is projected at \$425,000. Please note that Center City Partners is pursuing a Bike Share program that may alter this budget. The Board of the CCCP Community Trust has final responsibility for that review. MSD 1-4 funding increased \$123,077 from FY12 to FY13. Personnel expenses reflect merit salary increases of 1.82%. Total payroll, excluding benefits, taxes and fees increase 5.7% for FY13. The overall increase of personnel costs is 6.73% over FY12 budget. Employee medical care rates are projected to increase 12% in FY13. Dental, life and disability rates are projected to increase 5% in FY13. Overall, Center City Partners operating revenue is projected to decrease because the 2020 Vision Plan is complete.

The Budget for FY 2012 was unanimously approved.

#### 7<sup>th</sup> Street Public Market

A motion to loan the 7<sup>th</sup> Street Public Market \$100k, and develop a board subcommittee to outline conditions of the loan was unanimously approved.

#### **Board Class FY13**

Todd acknowledged and thanked Mary MacMillan and Bobby Drakeford for their years of service. The Board approved the FY13 Class of Directors which includes Cathy Bessant of Bank of America and Doug Stephan of Vision Ventures.

#### 7<sup>th</sup> Street Public Market

Michael reported that the 7<sup>th</sup> Street Public Market's grand opening will be held the week of May 12th.

#### **AAA Ballpark**

A motion was approved to submit a resolution to City Council offering support to a new AAA Ballpark for Uptown Charlotte.

Darrel Williams thanked the staff and Robert Krumbine for their excellent work on the 2012 Vision Awards. He reminded the board of the July 4<sup>th</sup> Presbyterian Hospital Spectacular.

#### **Planning and Development**

David Furman reported that 2020 Center City Executive Summaries have been handed out to each member and pointed out the development map that was created for distribution during ULI. Tryon Street received an award as one of American's top Main Streets.

This memo provides the consolidated statement of activities for Charlotte Center City Partners and CCCP Community Trust for FY13 year to date with comparisons to FY12.

Charlotte Center City Partners has budgeted FY13 revenue of \$5,645,482. MSD allotment from the City is projected to be \$3,814,743, 67% of our operating budget. CCCP revenue from programs, projects and events is projected to be \$238,500.

Additional revenues include CCCP Community Trust dba Charlotte ArtsFest, Inc. with revenue budgeted at \$425,000 which includes two major ArtsFest Events: Time Warner BBQ & Blues and First Night Charlotte and CCCP Community Trust dba B-cycle with revenue of \$803,239. CCCP is committed to raising \$364,000 for the Gold Rush Shuttle.

Charlotte Center City Partners budgeted FY13 expenses of \$5,520,482. The budgeted surplus of revenue over expenses is \$125,000 which is being created to protect against possible revaluation appeals and to help pre-fund our baseball economic development grant.

#### **Overall Results**

Year to date, July 31, 2012, Charlotte Center City Partners and CCCP Community Trust consolidated net revenues over expenses is ahead of budget with a positive variance of \$2,176. Revenue is \$13,700 favorable to budget and expenses are \$11,524 unfavorable to budget.

#### **Programs and Projects**

Program and Projects are ahead of budget by \$3,067.

#### **Planning & Development**

Planning & Development expenses are on budget.

#### **Events**

Event revenue and expenses are on budget.

#### Personnel expenses

Personnel expenses are on budget.

#### Quarters

Quarters expenses are slightly ahead of budget.

#### **General Operating Expenses**

Operating expenses are on budget.

#### **Investment Account**

The CCCP Investment Account had a value of \$906,536 on July 31, 2012. This is in comparison to a value of \$893,751 on June 30, 2012.
