

Commercial Plans Submittal Using Accela Citizen Access

Beginning January 7th, all commercial plan submittals will be occurring through Accela Citizen Access (ACA). You will no longer submit plans via email. All you will have to do is complete the application electronically and attach your plans and other documentation and submit. Electronic Document Review (EDR) is a fully integrated feature within Accela Automation that leverages Adobe Acrobat X Pro to provide review and markup of documents in the PDF format. Also, you will have access to review your marked up documents via Accela Citizen Access. We will be conducting two training sessions to demonstrate the use of ACA for plan submittal: Wednesday, December 12th at 9:00 and on Thursday, December 13th at 1:30. Both sessions will be held in the Government Center, Room CH-14 (basement). Pre-submittal Meetings

If you are planning to schedule a Friday presubmittal meeting, please note that the first availability is approximately 4 weeks out from the submittal of the request form. Please factor this into your project schedule.

Expedited Review

During the design phase of your project, and prior to submitting for an expedited review, please contact the Senior Engineer for your project, to determine if the project is eligible for the program. To determine who is your Senior Engineer, go to http://vc.charmeck.org/ click on Engineering/Survey then click on Engineering Land Development Inspectors. Type in the address of the project. Or, you can also call our customer service number, 704-336-6692, for staff to assist.
