




Annual Pregnancy Rates per 1,000 Females Age 15 to 17 by Race

Annual Pregnancy Rates per 1,000 Females Age 15 to 19 by Race



Annual Pregnancy Rates per 1,000 Females Age 18 to 19 by Race



Annual Pregnancy Rates per 1,000 Females Age 15 to 17


Mecklenburg County and North Carolina 1995 through 2008
