One outstanding issue raised at the August TCC meeting was with regard to the proposed realignment of Freedom Drive and its impact to the relocation site for the Thrift Depot. BACKGROUND: The metropolitan planning process must be implemented in urbanized areas (UZA). The Charlotte UZA extends into five counties (Cabarrus, Catawba, Gaston, Lancaster and York) served by existing MPOs, or by MPOs that plan to expand their planning areas. Based upon direction provided at previous MPO and TCC meetings, MUMPO will enter into agreements with the region's other MPOs to transfer its planning responsibilities.
