3. NC 218 Funding

ACTION REQUESTED: Recommend a course of action to the MPO.

BACKGROUND: Division 10 staff presented a proposal to the TCC at its May meeting to fund improvements to NC 218 from I-485 to Polkton. The proposal would have shifted funds from TIP project U-4024 (US 601 widening in Monroe) to the NC 218 improvements, resulting in a delay to U-4024. Division 10 staff is now recommending that the funds for NC 218 come from TIP project U-2507A (Graham St. Extension/Mallard Creek Road realignment in Charlotte). According to NCDOT staff, this will not result in a delay to the U-2507A project because an updated cost estimate shows that ROW costs are significantly lower than previously estimated.
