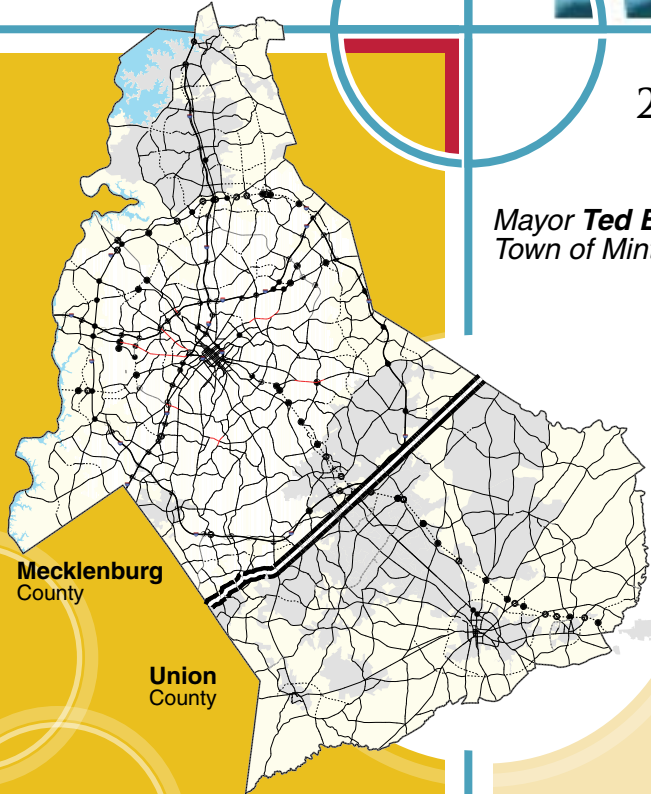

2035

LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN UPDATE



The preparation of the 2035 Long Range Transportation Plan is complete. Two public meetings were held during the last week of February to solicit comments on the following documents:

- Draft *2035 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)*
- *2009-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendments*
- Draft *Metrolina Air Quality Conformity Determination Report (CDR)*

At its March meeting, the documents will be reviewed by the TCC. The MPO, at its March meeting, is expected to endorse the documents for approval by the *Federal Highway Administration (FHWA)*. Final approval of the LRTP by the FHWA is required by May 2010.

Regional Transportation PLANNING INITIATIVES

There are currently three regional transportation planning initiatives underway or being planned:

1. The *Centralina Council of Governments (CCOG)* is studying methods to improve regional transportation planning, including the possible consolidation of the region's four MPOs. An assessment of the impact of the 2010 census, as well as an analysis of the advantages and disadvantages of consolidating the MPOs in the Charlotte Region are among the issues being addressed by this study.
2. The Charlotte Regional Partnership has begun a study to examine the possibility of MPO consolidation, specifically in the context of Senate Bill 910.
3. The Lake Norman Transportation Commission hosted an *Urban Land Institute (ULI)* panel in January 2010 to examine transportation and land use issues in northern Mecklenburg and southern Iredell counties.

Updates on these initiatives will be provided to the TCC and MPO.
