**3. TIP Project P-5200: Thrift Depot Relocation** (10 minutes) Craig Newton *ACTION REQUESTED: Recommend that the MPO approve the amendment to the TIP as presented.* 

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: NCDOT provided information to the TCC at its August meeting about a TIP project to relocate and stabilize the vacant Thrift Depot along the former P&N Railroad line in northeast Charlotte. The MPO is being asked to amend the TIP to allocate \$800,000 in Enhancement funds, matched with \$200,000 in state funds, in order to accomplish the proposed relocation of the historic structure. One outstanding issue raised at the August TCC meeting was with regard to the proposed realignment of Freedom Drive and its impact to the relocation site for the Thrift Depot. Attached are documents that address the Freedom Drive issue.

**4. TIP Project U-5519: N. Community House Road TIP/LRTP Amendments** (5 minutes) Robert Cook & **Conformity Determination**

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This project will result in the construction of a bridge over I-485 in south Charlotte. It is not in MUMPO's TIP, but is in the LRTP's 2025 horizon year. The requested action will amend the TIP to fund the project in FY 2013, and amend the LRTP to modify the project description to accurately reflect the project's scope. <u>BACKGROUND</u>: The metropolitan planning process must be implemented in urbanized areas (UZA). The Charlotte UZA extends into five counties (Cabarrus, Catawba, Gaston, Lancaster and York) served by existing MPOs, or by MPOs that plan to expand their planning areas. Based upon direction provided at previous MPO and TCC meetings, MUMPO will enter into agreements with the region's other MPOs to transfer its planning responsibilities.

**7. Hambright Road & Everette Keith Road Alignment Studies** (10 minutes) Zachary Gordon <u>ACTION REQUESTED</u>: Recommend that the MPO authorize a public involvement process under the Town of Huntersville's leadership.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The Town of Huntersville has started the process for the preparation of a small area plan for the Eastfield Road area. As part of this plan, the Town is working with MUMPO staff to complete alignment studies for Hambright Road (from Everette Keith Road to Eastfield Road) and Everette Keith Road (from Eastfield Road to Verhoeff Drive). An overview of the scope of work and timetable for these studies will be provided.

## **8. I-77 HOT Lanes** (20 minutes)

ACTION REQUESTED: Recommend that the MPO endorse the proposed project scenarios for analysis.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: An update on the status of the I-77 HOT Lanes project will be provided. In addition, NCDOT has requested that the following two new scenarios be considered for the widening of I-77 from I-277 in Charlotte to NC 150 in Mooresville:

1) Northern section (I-4750 HOT) 1 HOT lane (in each direction) Central section (I-5405) 2 HOT lanes (in each direction)

Southern section (I-3311C) 0 HOT lanes

2) Northern section (I-4750 HOT) 1 HOT lane (in each direction) Central section (I-5405) 1 HOT lane (in each direction)

Southern section (I-3311C) 0 HOT lanes

*In addition to these two scenarios proposed by the state, other scenarios could be discussed.*
