

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#### Introduction:

The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Planning Department selected ten adopted Area Plans for selective implementation utilizing the 2006 Bonds. The selection of the specific Adopted Plans was based on several factors; including diversity in economics, population, adoption date, location and suggested recommendations.

The Area Plan Implementation Program was established to provide for the implementation of City Council adopted Area Plans and the recommendations set forth within the said adopted plans.

Through the Area Plan Program, the City and the Planning Department intends to provide selected infrastructure improvements in a manner that augments and reduce the gaps between existing infrastructure programs.

The Area Plan Program investments will be used to build and strengthen Area Plan communities, create more livable neighborhoods and implement infrastructure consistent with City Council adopted Small Area Plan recommendations.

The following product represents the recommended Implementation Action Items as described within the adopted Area Plans. This product selectively focuses on infrastructure related Implementation Items for visual clarity and does not contain recommendations that are impractical to map.

This product is considered a snap shot of a "living document" and will change over time. Geographically mapped items are for illustrative purposes and do not necessarily represent specific locations; they are intended as a conceptual rendering of an area and do not imply the physical development of a recommended item will occur.
