Acknowledgements

Offenses, clearances, and arrests are classified and counted in accordance with the national Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) program.

The jurisdiction population for 2000 was estimated at 625,810 by using the 2000 Census population for the county and subtracting the populations for the five incorporated towns with their own police services. The 2001 and 2002 estimates were extrapolated by applying the Chamber of Commerce's yearly estimate of the percentage increase in the Mecklenburg County population in 2002 and 2002 to the Census base population for the jurisdiction.

This report was created with the assistance of Officer David Padgett, who created a number of the charts and graphs. The district map was created by Monica Nguyen in the department's GIS system. Frank McDowell assisted with compiling data from some of the mainframe files. Data was extracted from the mainframe records systems, monthly UCR reports, and other monthly summary reports of traffic collisions and citation/warning ticket records entered by the CMPD Records Bureau. Data for individual CMPD divisions was also supplied by the Training Academy, Recruitment, International Relations, Non-Emergency Police Services, HITS, Animal Control, Canine, SWAT, Aviation and Vehicle for Hire.

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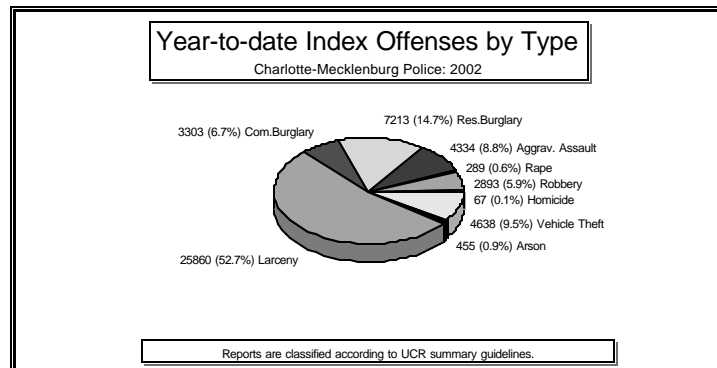

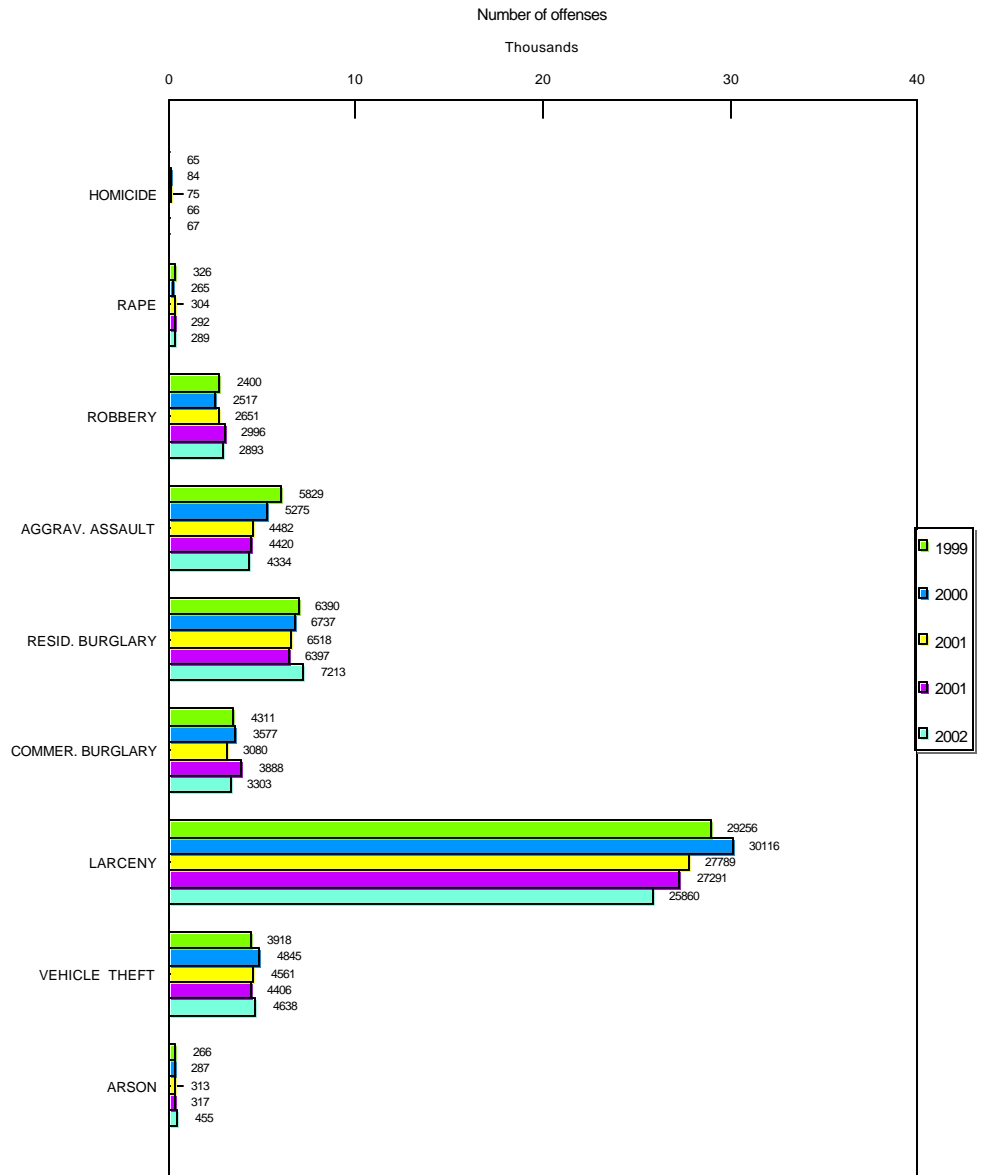
*In December, 2001, the aggravated assault totals were adjusted to include 210 offenses not counted in earlier months this year due to errors in the data on the weapons involved.

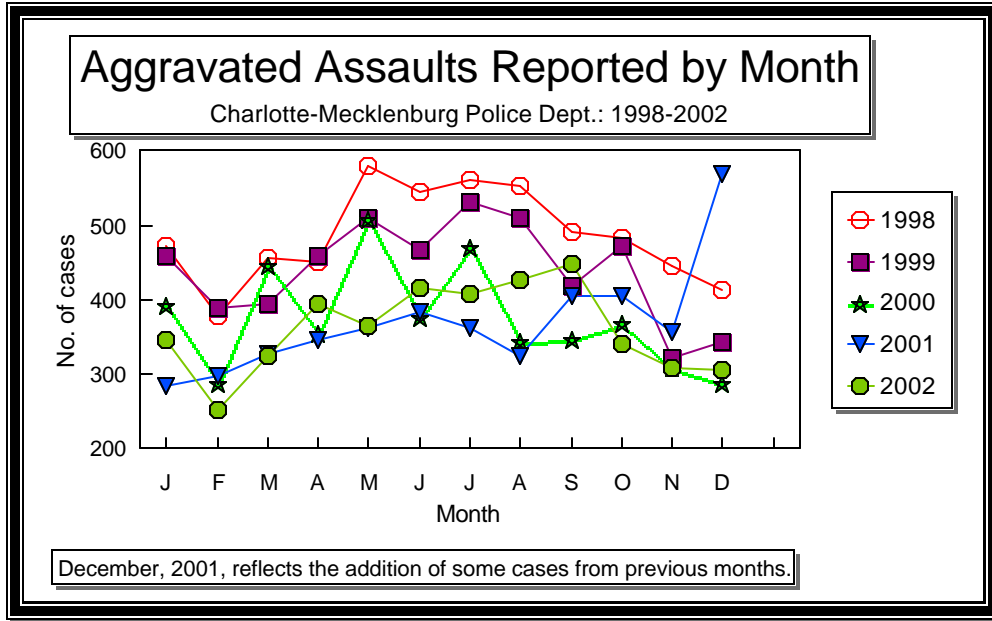

in the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Jurisdiction: 1998-2002**



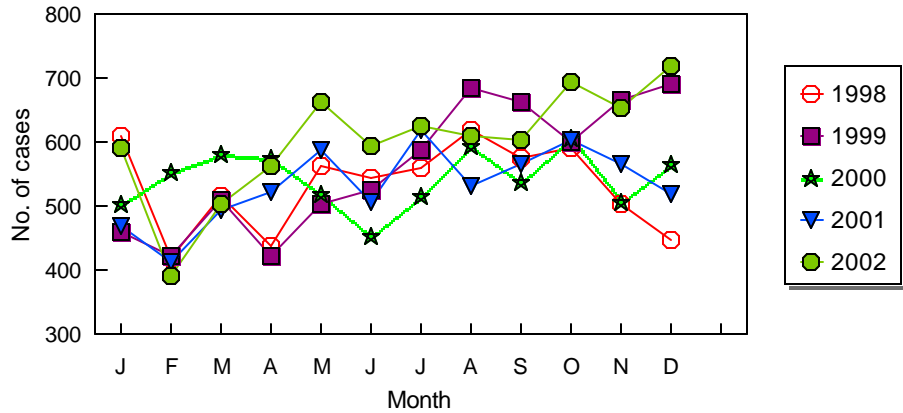






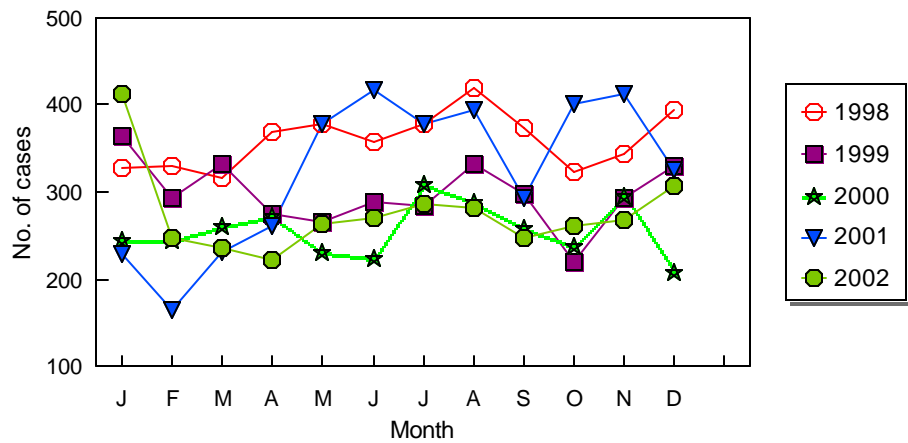
Residential Burglaries Reported by Month

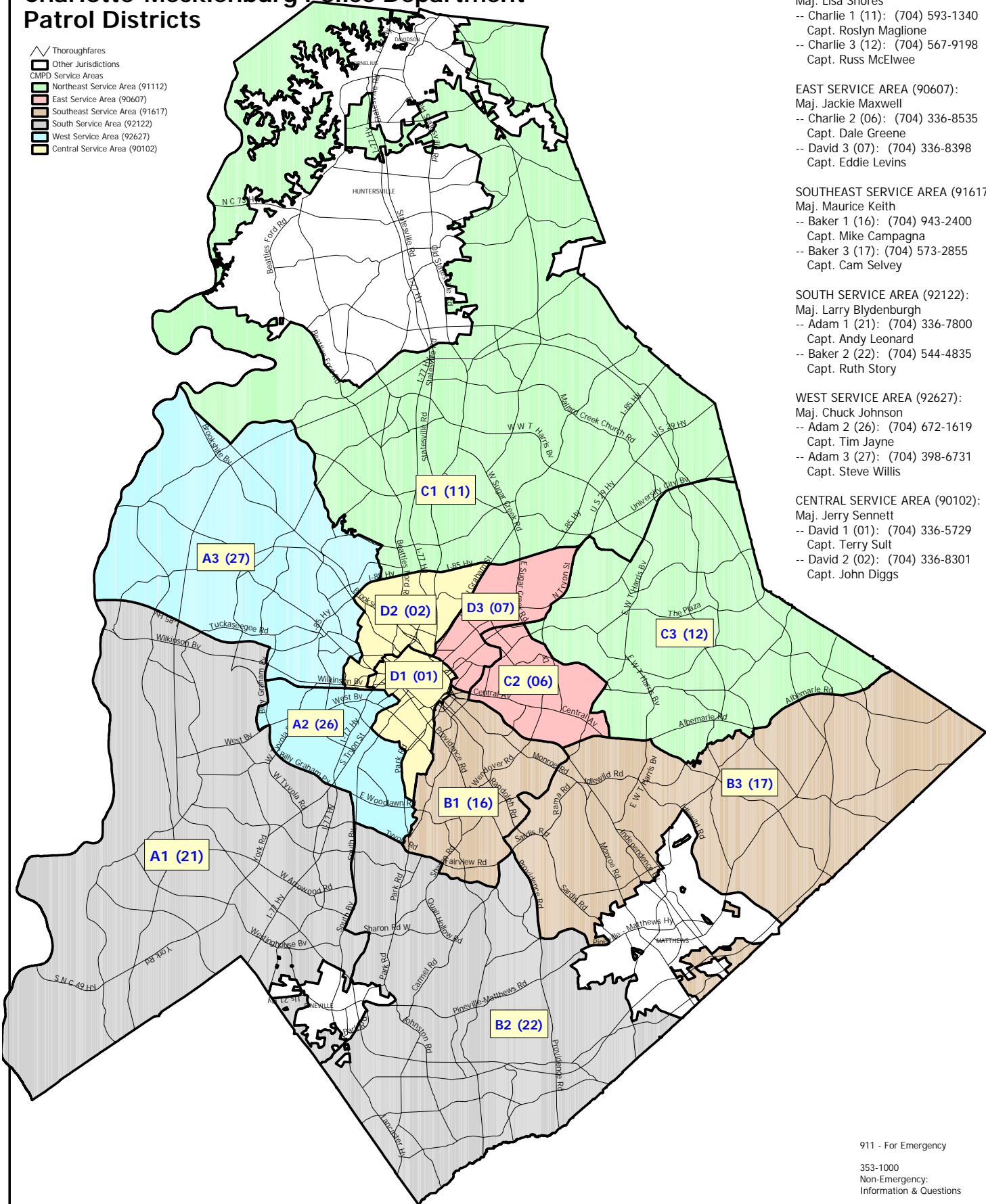
NOTE: According to Uniform Crime Reporting procedures, a case is cleared either by the arrest of an offender in the case or by an "exceptional clearance." An exceptional clearance occurs when law enforcement has identified an offender in the case, but for reasons outside law enforcement control (death of the offender, refusal of the victim or district attorney to prosecute, refusal to extradite, etc.), an arrest is not made.

The "clearance rate" is defined by Uniform Crime Reporting procedures as the percentage that represents the number of cases cleared during the year divided by the number of cases reported in that same year. Some clearances may be for cases that occurred in previous years.

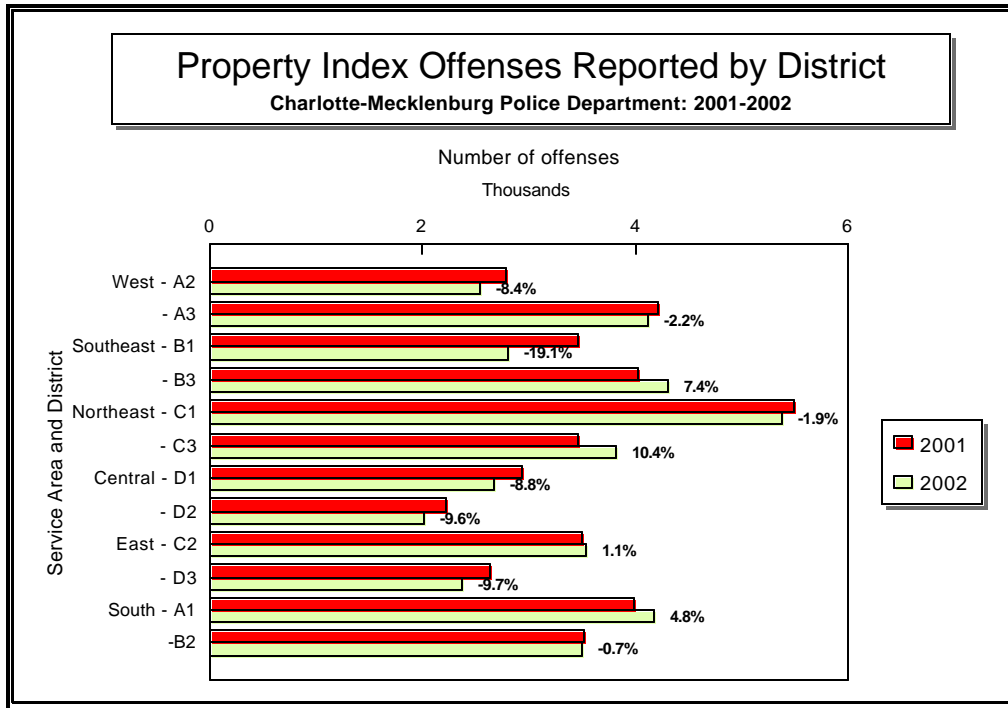
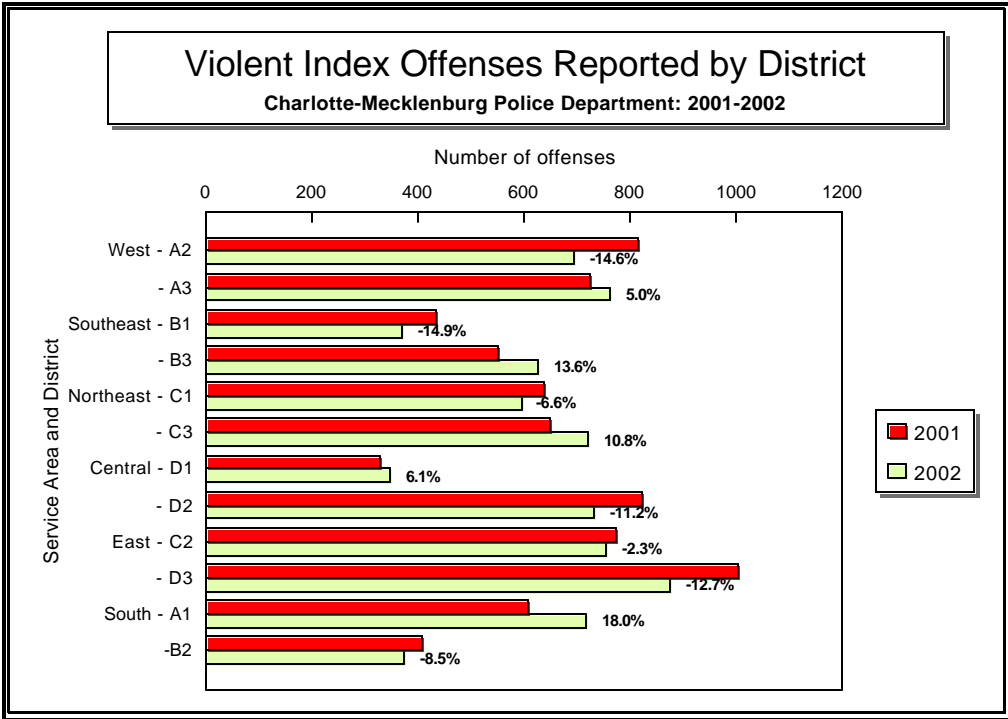
Reported Index Offenses in 2002

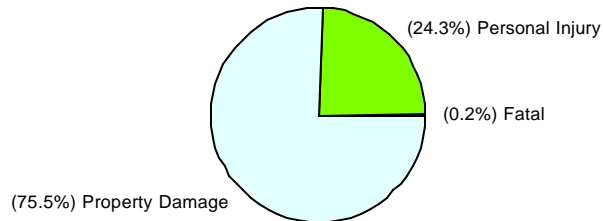

BY LOCATION (DISTRICT) OF INCIDENT: 2001-2002**



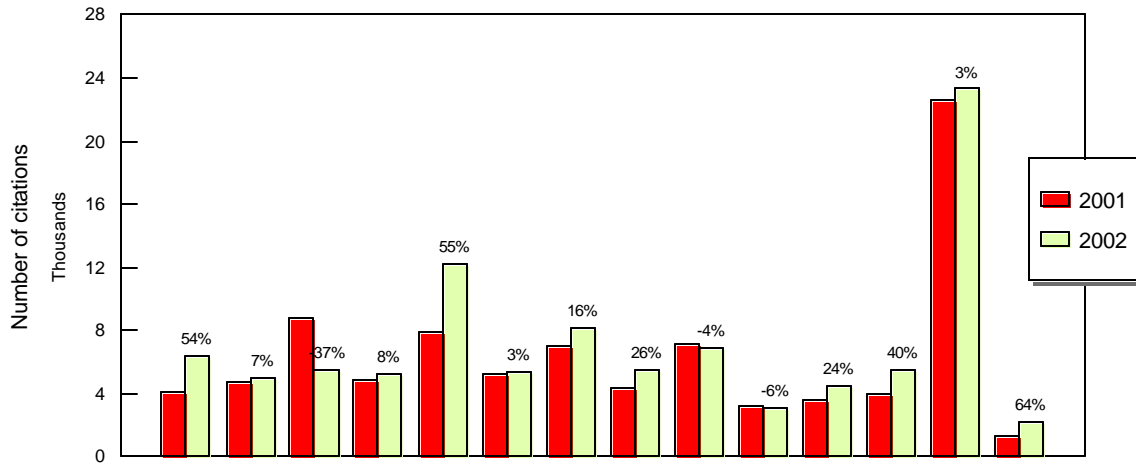

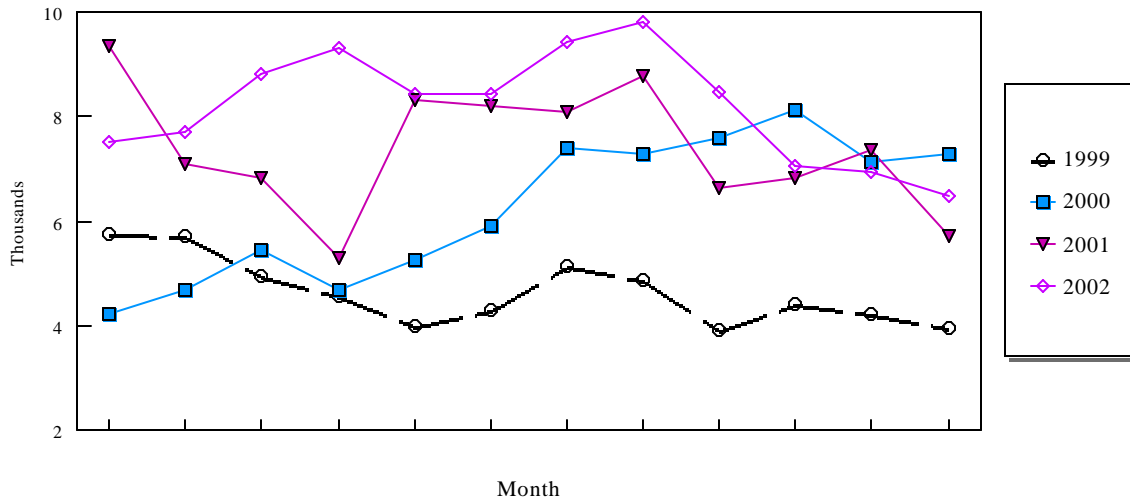

Citation Enforcement by Issuing Unit Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department: 2001-2002

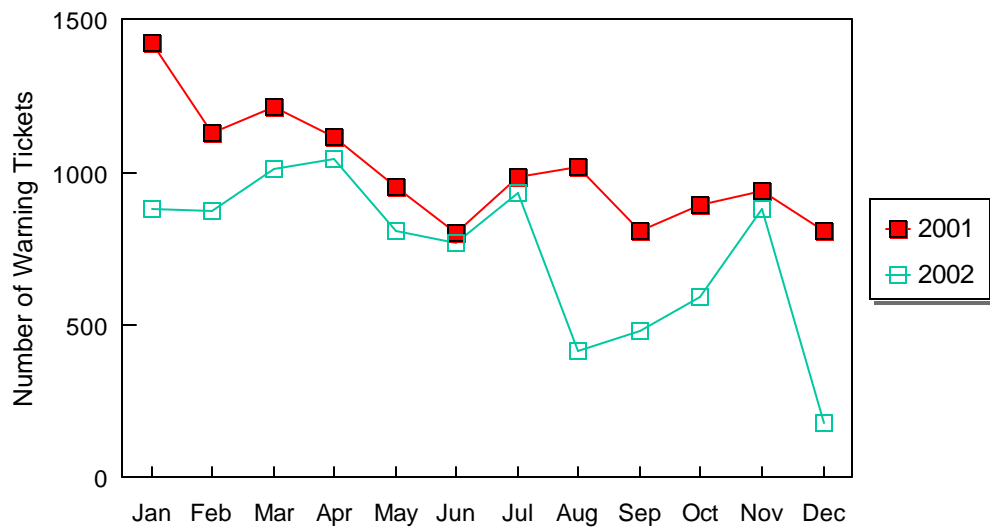


Citation Enforcement by Month Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department: 1999-2002

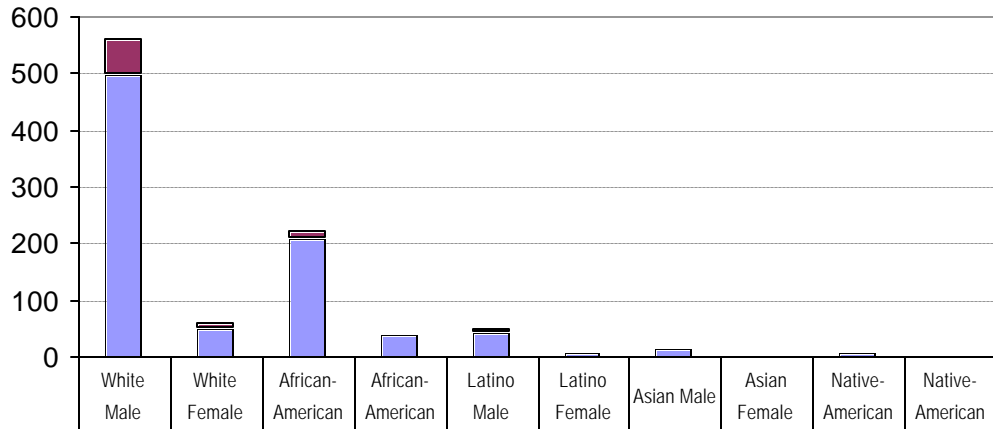
Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police K-9 Unit Calls by Month: 2002



K-9 Unit Calls by Activity Type

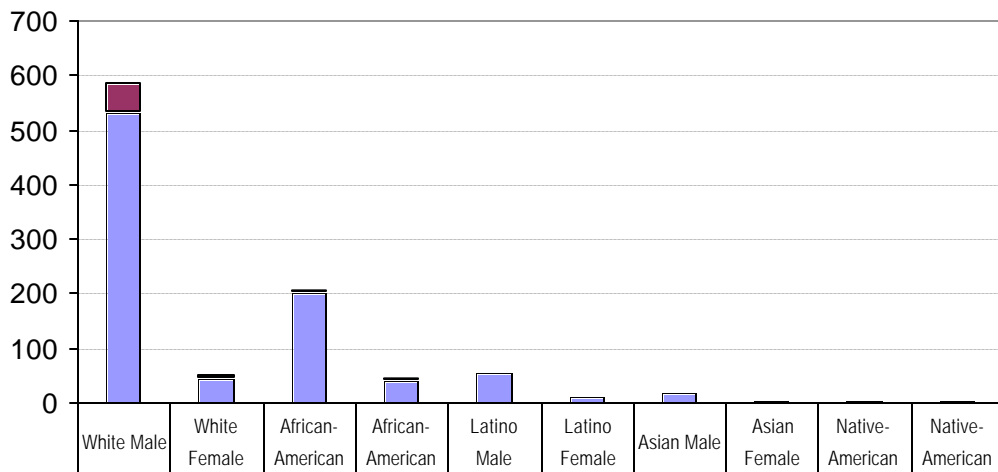

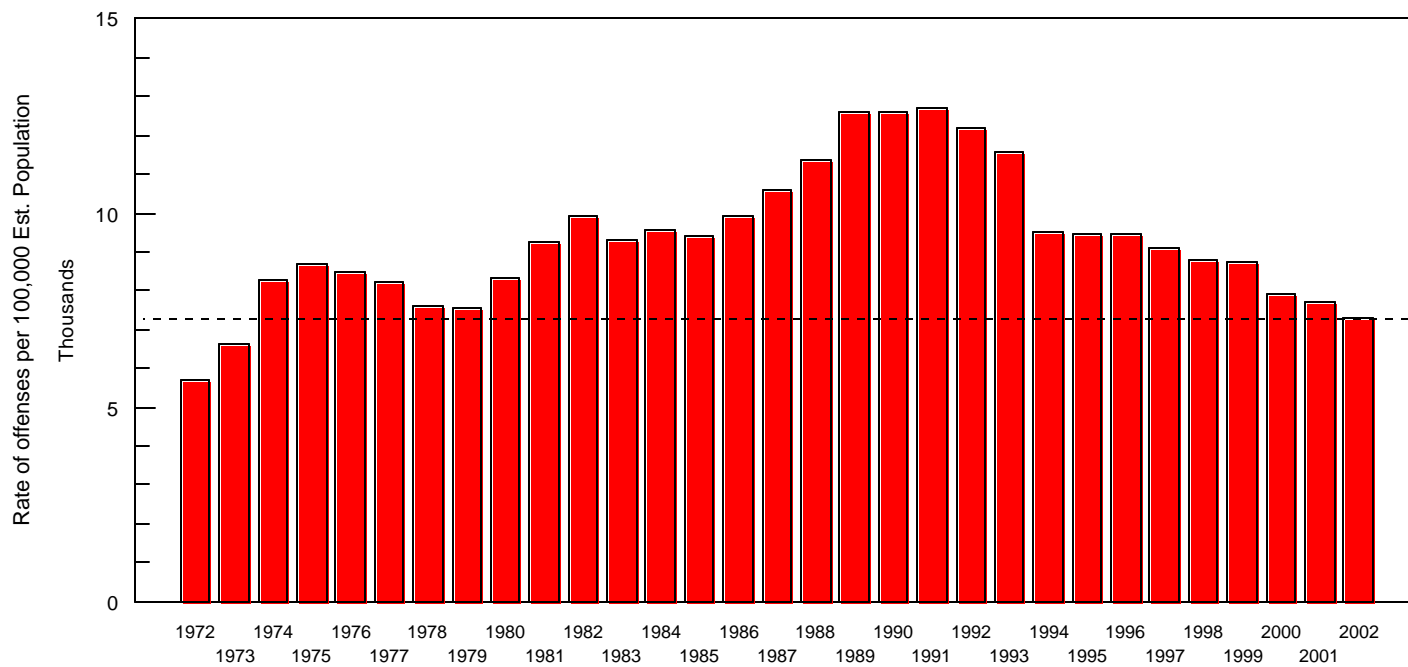

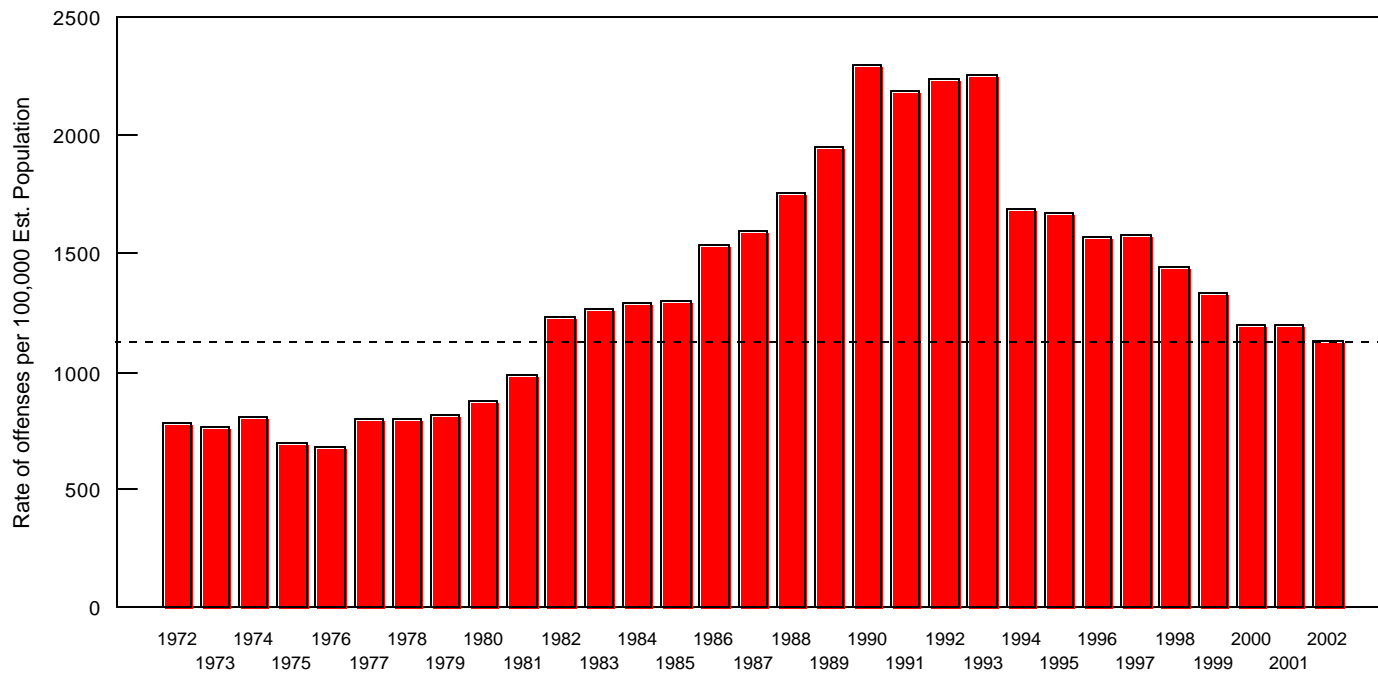
Index Crime Rates per 100,000 Est. Population for the Jurisdiction

Charlotte Police Department (1972-1993) and Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department (1994-2002)



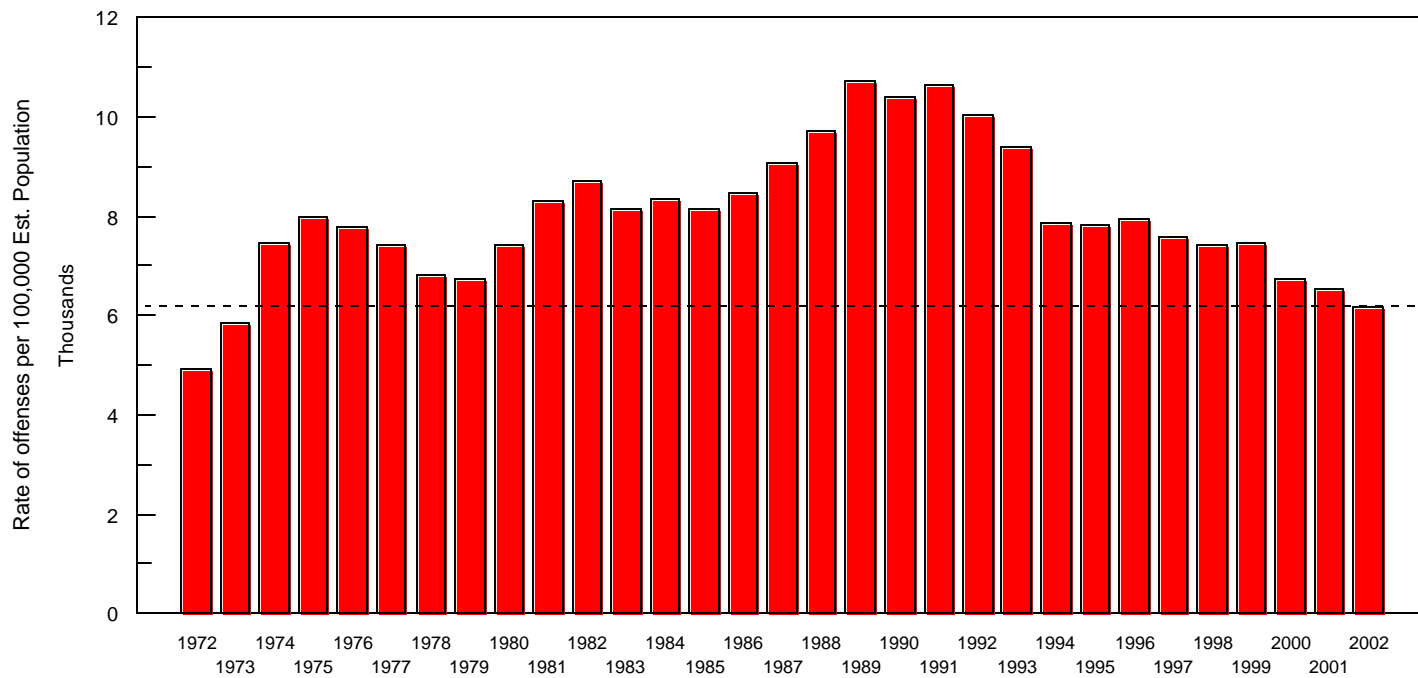
Violent Index Crime Rates per 100,000 Est. Population for the Jurisdiction

Uniform Crime Reporting Procedures:

The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department reports offense and arrest statistics in accordance with standard Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) guidelines. UCR policy states that any adjustments to previous months can be made on the current month's report:

...In tabulating crime counts, an agency may find that offense totals for past months require adjustments due to developments in the investigation or other handling of the matter. It may be necessary to adjust totals reported to UCR for the past month or prior months. Needed adjustments can be made on the current month's report and do not affect the reliability of the figures in that such adjustments tend to equalize each other from month to month over a period of time.

We are required to report crime monthly to the UCR program, and we do therefore make an effort to process monthly changes in a timely manner. However, occasionally due to the review and processing required for reclassifying, unfounding or clearing cases, the current month's totals may reflect the processing of a backlog of these changes from previous months.

Users of the data are cautioned that conclusions about substantial changes in crime trends or in clearance rates based on only a single month's data or trend may reflect some of these adjustments. For this reason, in addition to the monthly and year-to-date trends on Page 1, the monthly report routinely includes a comparison for the previous 12 months (p. 4), as well as graphs that provide seasonal/monthly comparisons over a five year period (p. 5-8).
