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

Figure 1. Number of Traffic Stops per Year






Figure 2. Racial Composition of Traffic Stops by Year








Figure 4. Racial Differences in the Likelihood of Search






Figure 5. Racial Differences in the Liklihood of Search by Gender





The figure shows the percentage difference in the likelihood of Hispanics being searched as compared to Whites by gender for motorists under 30.




Figure 7. Search Rates by Race, Gender, and Age Group




Figure 8. Number of Stops, by Race and Gender




Figure 9. Percent of Stops Resulting in a Search, by Race and Gender

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





Figure 10. Number of Hispanic and White Motorists Stopped, by Officer










Figure 12. Percent of White and Hispanic Drivers Searched, by Officer



# Figure A6. Stops by Day of the Week






Figure A7. Searches by Day of the Week




Figure A8. Stops by Hour of the Day




Figure A9. Searches by Hour of the Day




Figure A12. Racial Differences in the Likelihood of Search: Consent Searches Only
